

"Last Man Standing."

Traditional Shoot Off

A Very Special "Thank You" from the Black Knights to the Traditional Archers of New Jersey (TANJ) for their support in running the "Last Man Standing."

Sunday July 11th, 2021 at 11:30 AM at the Black Knights Range

- No Binoculars – No Range Finders.
- Open to Finger Shooting Recurve and Longbow shooters only for a \$5.00 fee.
- Must be a registered Bigfoot shooter wearing a wrist band to compete.
- Any target tipped arrow can be used – Wood, Aluminum or Carbon – No Flu-Flu Arrows,
- Your arrows must be identically matched including length and approximate weight.
- No sights, mechanical releases, or stabilizers. No counterbalanced or weights of any kind attached or built into the bow riser or used to replace limb bolts.
- No bow quivers, no clickers or new tab clickers allowed or draw check of any kind. Any side plate (if used) may only extend one (1) inch above the arrow.
- No string walking. The bow must be shot with fingers directly contacting the string using a glove, finger tab or bare fingers. Archers may use two (2) nock locating devices, but they must use the same nocking point and anchor point for each shot. The index finger either above or below the nocking point must always touch the nock of the arrow.
- Any bow riser or top limb marks must be covered with black tape. Markings on bowstring (intentional or accidental) can be construed as sighting marks and are not permitted.
- All fletching must be made of natural feathers. No vanes or plastic type material.
- 100% of all entry fees go back to the "Last Three Men Standing."
- Registration money Split 50%, 30%, 20% for 1st, 2nd & 3rd Place. All top six finishers will receive prizes
- Two arrows only at each of 5 targets at unmarked distances chosen at random, on the spot.
- Paper Animal Scoring will be scored, 5-4-3 and an extra point for the x ring. Hit's on all antlers or tails will be scored a zero.... NO points.
- Any shoot off will be done at a disclosed target on the day of the shoot.
- These rules subject to change based on suggestions from traditional archers only.
- When shooting one of the four small game faces the archer must announce which target, they are going to shoot at. i.e. Top - left or right, Bottom - left or right.
- **Your Shoot Chairmen are: Doc DeCaro, Jerry Mindurski, Rich Lopez and Daryll Shultz.**

How does it work? Example.....

- 50 Shooters register with an entry fee of \$5.00 each. After the first round of 2 arrows each, at 5 targets, the 25 lowest scoring shooters will be eliminated.
- The 25 remaining shooters shoot again at different distances chosen at random.
- Again, one half of the shooters (this time 13) will be eliminated)
- The remaining shooters will shoot again until the top three are determined
- All registration money will go to the top three shooters Split 50%, 30%, 20% for 1st, 2nd & 3rd.
- **The First Place Winner, aka the "Last Man Standing" will win a one-of-a-kind custom leather arm guard made by premier leathercrafter Aydar Rakmatulln, aka "Red Arrow" on Face Book . This armguard has been graciously donated by TANJ "Member at Large " Frank Florio.**
- In addition, the First-Place winner will also receive a beautiful "Last Man Standing" plaque designed and donated by Black Knight President Marty Ganley.
